

2023 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1225

Introduced by: Representative Healy

1 An Act to clarify informed consent requirements for the provision of prenatal and 2 postnatal care to minors.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 26-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5 If a minor seeks prenatal or postnatal care, a health care provider may offer the minor the opportunity to provide informed consent for such care, and thereafter act on 6 7 that consent, if the health care provider determines and documents that: 8 (1)The minor's parent is unavailable to provide informed consent; or The minor's parent is incapable, because of a mental or physical incapacity, of 9 (2) providing informed consent. 10 This section does not apply to an emancipated minor, as defined in § 25-5-24. 11
