## HOUSE BILL NO. 1252

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the placement of fluorescent orange material on
- 2 certain big game hunting blinds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 41-8-41 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 41-8-41. Any person hunting any big game animal, except turkey, with a firearm shall wear
- 6 in a visible manner one or more fluorescent orange exterior garments. The exterior garment shall
- 7 be a hat, cap, shirt, jacket, vest, coverall, or poncho worn above the waist. If the person is
- 8 hunting from a blind or uses other materials to provide concealment, the person shall place a
- 9 piece of fluorescent orange material that is at least one square foot in size outside of the blind
- 10 or cover so that it is visible to other hunters in the immediate area. A violation of this section
- 11 is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
