- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the enforcement of
- 2 the requirement to wear a seat belt in a motor vehicle.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 4 Section 1. That § 32-38-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 32-38-1. Except as provided in chapter 32-37 and § 32-38-3, every operator and front seat
- 6 passenger of a passenger vehicle operated on a public highway in this state shall wear a properly
- 7 adjusted and fastened safety seat belt system, required to be installed in the passenger vehicle
- 8 when manufactured pursuant to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard Number 208 (49 C.F.R.
- 9 571.208) in effect January 1, 1989, at all times when the vehicle is in forward motion. The
- 10 driver of the passenger vehicle shall secure or cause to be secured a properly adjusted and
- 11 fastened safety seat belt system on any passenger in the front seat who is at least five years of
- 12 age but younger than eighteen years of age. Any violation of this section is a petty offense and
- 13 is not a moving traffic offense under the provisions of § 32-12-49.1.
- 14 Section 2. That § 32-38-5 be repealed.
- 15 <u>32-38-5. Enforcement of this chapter by state or local law enforcement agencies shall be</u>



1	accomplished as a secondary action. A violation of this chapter is a petty offense.
2	Section 3. That chapter 32-38 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
3	follows:
4	For the purposes of this chapter, a passenger bus means any self-propelled vehicle used on
5	a highway to transport passengers if the passenger bus:
6	(1) Has a gross vehicle weight rating, or gross vehicle weight, of ten thousand one
7	pounds or more, whichever is greater; or
8	(2) Is designed or used to transport more than fifteen passengers, including the driver.
9	Section 4. The provisions of § 32-38-1 do not apply to any motor vehicle operated on private
10	property.
