## HOUSE EDUCATION ENGROSSED NO. **HB 1256** - 02/21/2014

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase opportunities and funding for school districts

2 to apply for jobs for America's graduates programs and to make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota's future fund the sum of one  
5 dollar (\$1), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the supplemental school fund.

6 Section 2. The secretary of education shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw  
7 warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act. If requests for funding exceed the amount  
8 available in th supplemental school fund, the secretary shall distribute the moneys on a pro rata  
9 basis.

10 Section 3. There is hereby established the supplemental school fund to provide additional  
11 funding for school districts with less than a ninety percent graduation rate to implement  
12 programs aimed at increasing graduation rates including Jobs for America's Graduates.

13 Section 4. The secretary of education shall monitor the graduation rate of each school district



1 that receives funding pursuant to this Act and shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26  
2 to establish an application process, reporting requirements, award amounts, school and program  
3 standards, and other areas required for the implementation of this Act.
