## HOUSE BILL NO. 1262

1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a license for certain small scale mechanized		
2	mining operations.		
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:		
4	Section 1. That chapter 45-6B be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as		
5	follows:		
6	An operator shall obtain a license to conduct small scale mechanized mining in accordance		
7	with the provisions of chapter 45-6. However, the operator may only:		
8	(1)	Use a high banker, spiral pans, trommel, dredge, or other earth-moving equipment	
9		that has less than eight horsepower which is cable of processing a maximum of three	
10		cubic yards of material per day per person;	
11	(2)	Use a dredge that has suction hose that is three inches or less in diameter and has less	
12		than eight horsepower;	
13	(3)	Operate a dredge between June first and September first;	
14	(4)	Use mechanized equipment, except a dredge, above the high water mark of a stream	
15		channel; and

1	(5)	Operate a dredge on the channel bottom. The dredge may not undercut the stream
2		bank or disturb the shoreline vegetation.

- 3 If the operator is licensed under chapter 45-6, such activities do not require permitting under
- 4 chapter 45-6B.
- 5 Section 2. That § 45-6B-71.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 45-6B-71.1. Any operator mining within one hundred feet of a lake or stream of this state

7 without a permit issued pursuant to this chapter <u>or without a license issued pursuant to chapter</u>

8 <u>45-6</u> is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
