- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to reduce the period of time necessary to cure and validate
- 2 certain adoption proceedings.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 25-6-21 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 25-6-21. Except in any case involving fraud, any proceeding for the adoption of a child
- 6 commenced under chapter 25-6 shall be in all things legalized, cured, and validated two years
- 7 one year after the proceeding is finalized. If any person has a claim or right arising from any
- 8 adoption proceeding, that person must shall initiate any action to enforce such right or claim
- 9 within two years one year of the date when the proceeding is finalized.
