

2022 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1298

1 An Act to reallocate federal payments from national forests.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 2
- 3 Section 1. That § 41-16-11 be AMENDED:

4 41-16-11. All money received from the forest service of the United States under 5 the Agricultural Act approved June 30, 1906, as receipts from the Black Hills National 6 Forest, shall be distributed annually to the counties of Lawrence, Meade, Pennington, 7 Custer, and Fall River, for the benefit of the public roads and public schools of such 8 counties, in proportion to the area of such Black Hills National Forest in each county is to 9 fund the Native American achievement schools grant program established under § 1-54-13.

11 Section 2. That § 41-16-12 be AMENDED:

12 **41-16-12.** All money received by the state treasurer as a percentage of the gross 13 receipts, from the Custer National Forest, shall be annually paid to Harding County for the 14 benefit of the public roads and public schools of such county is transferred to the local 15 infrastructure improvement grant fund established under § 1-16G-50 and reserved for 16 grants to tribal governments.
