A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Commending and honoring Jim Hagen in Pierre, South Dakota, for receiving the State Tourism Director of the Year Award.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Travel Association's National Council of State Tourism Directors votes annually on the State Tourism Director Award, which is given to the professional whose leadership has led to the measurable improvement of his or her state's travel and tourism profile; and

WHEREAS, Hagen has served as the secretary of tourism for Governor Dennis Daugaard since 2011. In this role, he oversaw the Offices of Tourism, Economic Development, Arts, History, and State-Tribal Relations; and

WHEREAS, Jim's passion for the industry and respect amongst his peers is demonstrated by the many national boards on which he serves, including the National Travel and Tourism Advisory Board, which advises the U.S. Secretary of Commerce on travel industry policy, the U.S. Travel Association Board, as well as several committees; and
