## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1001

- 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Recognizing the difference between the taxes and fees
- 2 levied by the State of South Dakota.
- WHEREAS, a tax is a compulsory financial contribution levied by a government for the
- 4 general support of the government and the services it provides; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a fee is a charge levied by a government on specific persons, activities, or
- 6 properties as payment for a direct benefit received; and
- WHEREAS, there is often confusion about the distinction between these two government
- 8 funding mechanisms, and certain individuals and groups, particularly at times of an election,
- 9 deliberately confuse voters about that distinction:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Ninetieth
- 11 Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that there is a clear and
- distinct difference between the taxes levied by the State of South Dakota and the fees levied
- by the State of South Dakota and the agencies thereof, and that an increase in fees is not an
- 14 increase in taxes.
