HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1010

Introduced by: Representatives Cronin, Gibson, Rausch, Rounds, and Verchio and Senators Brown, Gillespie, Gray, Hanson (Gary), Haverly, and Howie

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Requesting the appointment of a special task force to study
2 the highway needs and the financing of the highway needs for the state and its political
3 subdivisions.

4 WHEREAS, the Legislature requests the Governor to establish a Transportation
5 Infrastructure Task Force and to appoint its membership; and

6 WHEREAS, the task force members shall include the executive director of the South Dakota
7 Petroleum and Propane Marketers Association; a representative from the wholesale fuel
8 business - either petroleum or propane; a representative from the bulk fuel business - either
9 petroleum or propane; a representative from a retail convenience store; the executive director
10 of the South Dakota Association of Cooperatives; the executive director of the South Dakota
11 Auto Dealers Association/South Dakota Truckers Association; a South Dakota based
12 automobile dealer; a South Dakota based trucking firm representative; a representative of the
13 ethanol producers who is based in South Dakota; two citizens from the state of South Dakota
14 who live in the state at least ten months of the year; and a representative of the Governor's
15 Office; and



1 WHEREAS, the Transportation Infrastructure Task Force shall study the many different
2 funding sources, present and future, that should be enacted to fund the needs of both state and
3 local roads in the state of South Dakota; and

4 WHEREAS, the Governor shall make the initial appointments by May 1, 2010. If any
5 vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as the original
6 appointment was made; and

7 WHEREAS, all task force members shall be volunteers and there will be no compensation
8 for serving on this task force, the members shall elect a chair and vice chair, and the members
9 shall provide the necessary support to coordinate the meetings:

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Eighty-
11 fifth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the Governor
12 should appoint a special task force to study the highway needs and the financing of highway
13 needs in the state; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the task force shall report to the Governor's office and
15 the Legislature its findings and recommendations by November 15, 2010. The Governor shall
16 submit legislation, if any required, to implement the recommendations of the task force.
