House Concurrent Resolution 6009

Introduced by: Representative Jensen (Phil)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Condemning Rape as a tactic of war.

2 WHEREAS, international law has prohibited rape and other forms of sexual violence

3 against women during armed conflict for over a century; and

4 WHEREAS, the four Geneva Conventions and their two additional protocols implicitly and

5 explicitly condemn rape as well as other forms of sexual violence; and

- 6 WHEREAS, rape and other forms of sexual violence are considered grave breaches of the
- 7 <u>Geneva Convention and are war crimes; and</u>

8 WHEREAS, Article 27 of the Fourth Geneva Convention states that women shall be

9 especially protected against any attack on their honor, in particular against rape, enforced

10 prostitution, or any form of indecent assault; and

WHEREAS, the International Committee of the Red Cross stresses that rape and other
 forms of sexual violence are considered to be grave breaches; and

- WHEREAS, Hamas has committed many atrocities since its attack on October 7, 2023,
 including rape and sexual violence; and
- 15 <u>WHEREAS, first responders in Israel told reporters the October 7th attack was</u>
 16 <u>overwhelmingly gruesome and many female victims were found undressed and mutilated;</u>
- 17 <u>and</u>
- 18 <u>WHEREAS, there were instances of girls with broken pelvises or broken legs due to Hamas'</u>
 19 <u>sexual violence; and</u>

1	WHEREAS, Hamas has held an estimated one hundred thirty-six hostages, including
2	American citizens, for over one hundred days and are reluctant to release hostages due to
3	the horrendous abuse that could be reported; and
4	WHEREAS, the Israel Defense Forces released a statement saying that it remains
5	committed to returning all Israeli hostages and dismantling Hamas; and
6	WHEREAS, the details of Hamas' attack on Israel are so horrible, they cannot be further
7	detailed; and
8	WHEREAS, President Joe Biden has called on all people, governments, international
9	organizations, civil society, and businesses, to forcefully condemn the sexual violence of
10	Hamas terrorists without equivocation; and
11	WHEREAS, the United States ambassador to the United Nations, Linda Thomas-Greenfield,
12	asked where the universal condemnation was and said that any gender-based violence should
13	not be sidelined:
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Ninety-Ninth
15	Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the Legislature
