- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Making formal application to Congress to call an Article V
- 2 convention of the states for the sole purpose of proposing a federal balanced budget
- 3 amendment.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH
- 5 DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of South Dakota hereby applies to Congress, under
- 7 the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United States, for the calling of a
- 8 convention of the states limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United
- 9 States requiring that in the absence of a national emergency, the total of all federal
- appropriations made by Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated
- federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal restraints;

- WHEREAS, this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with

1 Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of

the several states have made applications on the same subject. It supersedes all previous

- applications by this Legislature on the same subject:
- 4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Ninetieth
- 5 Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the State of South
- 6 Dakota does hereby apply to the Congress of the United States to call an amendment convention
- 7 pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution limited to proposing an amendment to
- 8 the United States Constitution requiring that in the absence of a national emergency, the total
- 9 of all federal appropriations made by Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of
- all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate
- 11 fiscal restraints; and

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this application is to be considered as covering the same
- subject matter as the presently outstanding balanced budget applications from other states,
- 14 including previously-adopted applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado,
- 15 Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi,
- 16 Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio,
- Pennsylvania, Tennessee, and Texas. This application shall be aggregated with same for the
- purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require the calling of a convention for
- 19 proposing a balanced budget amendment but may not be aggregated with any applications on
- any other subject; and
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the other states be encouraged to make similar
- 22 applications for an amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the
- 23 United States; and
- 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this application constitutes a continuing application

- 1 for such amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States
- 2 until the legislatures of two-thirds of the states have made such applications and such
- 3 convention has been called by the Congress of the United States; and
- 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the secretary of state transmit copies of this resolution
- 5 to the President of the United States, the Speaker and the Clerk of the United States House of
- 6 Representatives, the President and the Clerk of the United States Senate, the members of the
- 7 South Dakota congressional delegation, and the legislatures of each of the several states,
- 8 attesting the adoption of this resolution by the Legislature of the State of South Dakota.
