HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1006

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing a constitutional amendment to revise the legislative vote 2 required to impose, increase, or authorize taxes. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH 3 4 DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 5 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendments to 6 Article XI, section 13 and section 14 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set 7 forth in sections 2 and 3 of this Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted 8 to the electors of the state for approval. 9 Section 2. That Article XI, section 13 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be 10 repealed. 11 § 13. The rate of taxation imposed by the state of South Dakota on personal or corporate 12 income or on sales or services, or the allowable levies or the percentage basis for determining 13 valuation as fixed by law for purposes of taxation on real or personal property, shall not be 14 increased unless by consent of the people by exercise of their right of initiative or by two-thirds 15 vote of all the members elect of each branch of the Legislature.

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Section 3. That Article XI, section 14 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be

- 3 § 14. The rate of taxation imposed by the State of South Dakota in regard to any tax may not
- 4 be increased and, no new tax may be imposed, nor may any new tax or tax increase be
- 5 <u>authorized</u> by the State of South Dakota unless by consent of the people by exercise of their
- 6 right of initiative or by two-thirds vote of all the members elect of each branch of the
- 7 Legislature.
