| 4 | BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF SOUTH |
| 5 | DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: |
| 6 | Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to |
| 7 | Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section 2 |
| 8 | of this Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state |
| 9 | for approval. |
| 10 | Section 2. That Article III, section 6 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be |
| 11 | amended to read as follows: |
| 12 | § 6. The terms of office of the members of the Legislature shall be two years; they four years |
| 13 | for each term of office beginning in a year that ends in a three or a seven and two years for each |
| 14 | term of office beginning in a year that ends in a one. Legislators shall receive for their services |
| 15 | the salary fixed by law under the provisions of § 2 of article XXI of this Constitution, and five |

1 cents for every mile of necessary travel in going to and returning from the place of meeting of

- 2 the Legislature on the most usual route.
- No person may serve more than four three consecutive terms or a total of eight ten
- 4 consecutive years in the senate and, whichever is longer. No person may serve more than four
- 5 three consecutive terms or a total of eight ten consecutive years in the house of representatives,
- 6 <u>whichever is longer</u>. However, this restriction does not apply to partial terms to which a
- 7 legislator may be appointed.
- 8 A regular session of the Legislature shall be held each year and shall not exceed forty
- 9 legislative days, excluding Sundays, holidays and legislative recess, except in cases of
- impeachment, and members of the Legislature shall receive no other pay or perquisites except
- 11 salary and mileage.
