

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to provide a statutory reference for the code of ethics for certified teachers and administrators.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 13-42-9 be amended to read as follows:

13-42-9. The secretary of the Department of Education may revoke or suspend any certificate for any cause which would have prevented its issue, plain violation of contract, gross immorality, incompetency, violation of the code of ethics, established pursuant to § 13-43-25 or 13-43-45, as determined by the Professional Teachers Practices and Standards Commission or the Professional Administrators Practices and Standards Commission, or flagrant neglect of duty, and may suspend any certificate for a period not to exceed one year for breaking or jumping a contract, if such suspension is requested by the school board. However, the secretary may not suspend a certificate for breaking or jumping a contract if the school board collected liquidated damages pursuant to the terms of the contract.
