- 2 government forms to decline to specify the person's race on the form.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. If any application form, reporting form, survey form, or other form that is
- 5 required, produced, or used by any state agency or political subdivision of the state directs the
- 6 person completing the form to indicate the person's race, the form shall include an option that
- 7 enables the person to decline to specify any racial category.
