## SENATE BILL NO. 108

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the practice of  
2 cosmetology.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-15-2 be amended to read:

5 36-15-2. No person may engage in the practice of cosmetology unless the person is licensed  
6 by the commission. A person is engaged in the practice of cosmetology if that person, for  
7 compensation, a fee, or any valuable consideration, engages in any of the following practices  
8 with hands, chemicals, or any mechanical or electrical apparatus or appliance for beautifying  
9 or cosmetic purposes:

10 (1) Hair care by styling, wrapping, arranging, braiding, twisting, weaving, extending,  
11 fusing, dressing, curling, waving, permanent waving, singeing, ~~cleansing,~~  
12 ~~shampooing,~~ cutting, bleaching, setting, coloring, straightening, relaxing, fitting,  
13 massaging, or similar work upon the hair, scalp, wigs, or hairpieces of a person;

14 (2) Nail technology;



- 1 (3) Esthetics; or
- 2 (4) Removal of superfluous hair by nonpermanent means. The practice of cosmetology
- 3 does not include hair cleansing or shampooing.
