3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million dollars
- 5 (\$1,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the state treasurer for the purpose of
- 6 providing matching funds in support of Dakota promise grants.
- 7 Section 2. That chapter 13-55 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 8 There is established in the state treasury the Dakota promise fund. The fund consists of:
- 9 (1) Gifts, grants, and donations, deposited by or on behalf of an institution of higher
- 10 education in this state, for the purpose of providing Dakota promise grants to eligible
- 11 students in accordance with this Act;
- 12 (2) Any interest or income earned on the deposits; and
- 13 (3) One dollar in matching funds, or such lesser prorated amount, provided by the state
- 14 treasurer for each dollar deposited into the fund by or on behalf of an institution.

12	five hund	red dollars nor more than two thousand dollars annually. An eligible student is one
13	who:	
14	(1)	Was a South Dakota resident at the time of graduating from high school;
15	(2)	Has been awarded a federal Pell Grant in the maximum amount allowed by the
16		United States Department of Education;
17	(3)	Attends an institution of higher education that is:
18		(a) Under the control of the Board of Regents; or
19		(b) A private baccalaureate degree granting institution accredited by the Higher
20		Learning Commission and located in this state; and
21	(4)	Initially enrolls in and thereafter successfully completes at least fifteen credit hours
22		per semester.
23	Sectio	on 5. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
24	Upon	receiving verification from the Board of Regents regarding the eligibility of the

student, the state treasurer shall forward the grant to the institution of higher education on behalf

- of the student. The institution may apply the grant toward the student's:
 (1) Tuition and fees;
 (2) Required books, supplies, or equipment; or
 (3) Room and board expenses.
- 6 Section 6. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 7 A student may receive a Dakota promise grant for up to four academic years, or until such
- 8 time as the student obtains a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.
