- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to expand medicaid eligibility for pregnant women and to
- 2 provide an appropriation therefor.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. The Department of Social Services shall submit a Medicaid State Plan
- 5 amendment to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to expand medicaid
- 6 eligibility for pregnancy-related services for pregnant women.
- 7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of two million six
- 8 hundred thousand dollars (\$2,600,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and three
- 9 million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$3,700,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- of federal fund expenditure authority to the Department of Social Services for the purpose of
- providing pregnancy-related services to pregnant women.
- Section 3. The secretary of social services shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
- draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
- June 30, 2012, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.



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- 1 Section 5. The Department of Social Services shall provide a report to the Governor and
- 2 the Legislature by January 1, 2013. The report shall include birth outcomes and any estimated
- 3 savings.
