- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That § 23-7-45 be AMENDED:

23-7-45. Exceptions to prohibition against possession of pistols by minors.

The provisions of § 23-7-44 or to are not applicable to a minor and a criminal prosecution for possession of a pistol brought after transfer pursuant to chapter $26-11_7$ do not apply to any is not applicable to a minor who has if the minor had the prior written consent of the minor's parent or guardian to possess such the pistol, and:

- (1) That the minor was in the presence of the minor's parent or guardian;
- (2) That the The minor was on premises owned or leased by the minor or the minor's parent, guardian, or immediate family member;
- (3)(2) That the The minor was in the presence of a licensed or accredited gun safety instructor; or
- (4)(3) That the The pistol was being used for farming, ranching, hunting, trapping, target shooting, or gun safety instruction.
