- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to ensure certain rights related to the marketing of products,
- 2 commodities, and livestock.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. The right to market products, commodities, or livestock may not be infringed
- 5 upon or limited because of any private property owner's refusal to sign any contract or to
- 6 participate in any program that limits, restricts, or denies any property right or right of privacy.
