

2023 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 128

Introduced by: Senator Frye-Mueller

1 An Act to remove the option to register to vote by a signed statement.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 12-4-5.4 be AMENDED:

4 12-4-5.4. Any person registering to vote shall provide the person's valid South 5 Dakota driver license number or a South Dakota nondriver identification number on the 6 voter registration form. If a person does not have a valid South Dakota driver license or 7 a South Dakota nondriver identification number, the person shall provide the last four 8 digits of the person's social security number on the voter registration form. If a person 9 does not have a valid South Dakota driver license, a South Dakota nondriver identification 10 number, or a social security number, the person may only register at the county auditor's 11 office and shall sign a statement verifying the fact that the person does not have a valid 12 South Dakota driver license, a South Dakota nondriver identification number, or a social 13 security number. The statement shall be prescribed by the State Board of Elections.
