| 5  | Section 1. To ensure the health and safety of South Dakota consumers that buy products                |
| 6  | over the internet through online marketplace platforms and unknowingly buy from any business          |
| 7  | located in this state, but not registered and licensed to conduct business in this state, each online |
| 8  | marketplace platform shall submit a report to the Office of the Secretary of State, on a calendar     |
| 9  | quarterly basis, the name and address of each business that is engaged in commerce through the        |
| 10 | platform that has sales exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars in the previous calendar          |
| 11 | quarter through the platform.   |
| 12 | For the purposes of this section, the term, online marketplace platform, means an online              |
| 13 | marketplace that provides consumer-to-consumer and business-to-consumer sales services                |
| 14 | through the internet.   |
| 15 | Section 2. To ensure that each employee of any online marketplace business located, but not           |

- 2 the law as any employee of a business that is registered in this state, each online marketplace
- 3 platform shall report to the Office of the Secretary of State, on a calendar quarterly basis, the

- 5 exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars during the previous calendar quarter through the
- 6 platform.
