- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require all students leaving an accredited school for an
- 2 alternative education program to wait one year before participating in interscholastic
- 3 activities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 13-36-7 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 13-36-7. Any student enrolling in a South Dakota district pursuant to § 13-15-21 is eligible
- 7 to participate in any interscholastic activity sponsored by the South Dakota High School
- 8 Activities Association. If the school board or governing body of an accredited school approves,
- 9 a student receiving alternative instruction pursuant to § 13-27-3 is eligible to participate in any
- 10 interscholastic activity sponsored by the South Dakota High School Activities Association.
- 11 Nothing in this section confers any vested right in any student wishing to participate in any
- 12 interscholastic activity to be selected for competition in such activity. However, any accredited
- school student who leaves an accredited program during the course of the school year for any
- 14 reason and enters an alternative instruction program is ineligible for participation in
- interscholastic activities for one year beginning on the date in which the student enters the
