- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to rehabilitate certain state-owned
- 2 rail lines and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of thirty-eight dollars
- 5 (\$38), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the railroad trust fund created in § 49-16C-1
- 6 for costs associated with the rehabilitation of the state-owned rail line between Chamberlain and
- 7 Presho.
- 8 Section 2. The secretary of transportation shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
- 9 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 10 Section 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
