SENATE ENGROSSED

Introduced by: Senator Castleberry

- 1 An Act to prohibit certain persons from using the title veterinary technician.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 36-12 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- A person who is not registered as a veterinary technician by the State Board of

 Veterinary Medical Examiners, or whose registration is suspended or revoked, may not:
- 6 (1) Assume or use the title veterinary technician; or
 - (2) Advertise or otherwise represent oneself as a veterinary technician.

A veterinarian may not advertise or otherwise represent an employee as a veterinary technician unless the employee is registered by the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners as a veterinary technician.

A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.

Section 2. That chapter 36-12 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

13		Prior to July 1, 2025, a person who is not registered as a veterinary technician by
14	the S	tate Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners may not assume or use the title
15	<u>veteri</u>	nary technician unless the person:
16	<u>(1)</u>	Has successfully completed a veterinary technician course of study approved by
17		the board; and
18	<u>(2)</u>	Submits a notarized document to the board from the person's employing
19		veterinarian certifying that the person:
20		(a) Has at least five years of practical experience working under the supervision
21		of the veterinarian; and
22		(b) Has agreed to become registered as a veterinary technician under chapter
23		36-12 by July 1, 2025.
24		A veterinarian may advertise or otherwise represent an employee as a veterinary
25	techn	ician who satisfies the requirements of this section.

1 **Section 3.** Section 1 of this Act is effective July 1, 2025.
