## Senate Bill no. 143

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding tourist-oriented
- 2 directional signs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 31-29-80.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 31-29-80.1. The transportation commission shall adopt promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 6 1-26, to provide for a directional sign program to provide directional information on the right-7 of-way on the interstate and primary highway system for any business establishments 8 establishment offering goods and services in the interest of the traveling public on the 9 right-of-way on the interstate and primary highway system including any attraction. The rules 10 shall be developed in conformance with the manual on uniform traffic control devices and shall 11 address permit application criteria; sign message and types of qualifying services; hours and 12 periods of operation; qualifying distance to services; business sign priority; sign and panel 13 locations and spacing; number and priority of signs per panel; sign and panel composition, size 14 and color requirements; legend requirements; exit ramp sign size, spacing and message content;



1 covering or removal of business signs; and erection and maintenance of signs and panels.

Section 2. That chapter 31-29 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
follows:

For the purposes of § 31-29-80.1, the term, attraction, means a business establishment of
regional significance with the primary purpose of providing amusement, historical, cultural, or
leisure activity to the public and has restroom facilities and drinking water and adequate parking
accommodations.

8 Section 3. That chapter 31-29 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as9 follows:

For the purposes of § 31-29-80.1, a business establishment shall be either a rural business or a tourist-oriented business. The business establishment may have an on-premise sign located adjacent to or visible from a highway which advertises the business.
