- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 Any person who intentionally refuses to stop or otherwise flees after being given a visual
- or audible signal to stop by a law enforcement officer is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor. The
- 7 law enforcement officer must have reasonable suspicion of criminal activity to initiate the stop.
