## SENATE BILL NO. 159

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase the maximum allowable uniform charge relating
- 2 to 911 emergency services.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 34-45-4 be amended to read as follows:

5 34-45-4. Upon compliance with § 34-45-2, the governing body may assess a monthly 6 uniform charge in an amount not to exceed seventy-five one dollar and fifty cents per service 7 user line. Any prepaid wireless telecommunications service provider shall remit the 911 8 emergency surcharge for each active prepaid wireless telecommunication service user account 9 to the South Dakota 911 coordination fund. The proceeds are continuously appropriated for 10 reimbursement of nonrecurring and recurring costs of 911 service and operating expenses of the 11 board. No such charge may be imposed upon more than one hundred service user lines or 12 equivalent service, per customer account billed, per month. In the case of multi-station network 13 systems, service user lines shall be equal to the number of calls that can simultaneously be made 14 from such system to the public switched telephone network.
