- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the disclosure of certain cumulative contracts
 with the state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 5-18A-34 be amended to read:

5 5-18A-34. The Bureau of Administration shall serve as the central procurement agency of 6 the State of South Dakota. Except for the legislative and judicial branches and as otherwise 7 specifically provided in this chapter and chapters 5-18B, 5-18C, and 5-18D, the Bureau of 8 Administration shall procure, or authorize the procurement of all supplies and public 9 improvements for state government. No claim for any such procurement may be paid unless 10 authorization has been issued by the bureau. All state agencies and institutions are responsible 11 for the procurement of services for their respective governmental unit. If one or more 12 procurement agencies enter into contracts with a person that cumulatively exceed fifty thousand 13 dollars, the bureau shall post the name of the contractors and the subject and value of the 14 contracts on the bureau's website. The governing body of all other purchasing agencies, including 15 the legislative and judicial branches of state government, is responsible for procuring or



- 1 authorizing the procurement of supplies, services, and public improvements for their respective
- 2 governmental unit.
