

2021 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 168 ENROLLED

AN ACT

ENTITLED An Act to revise the population requirement for appointment of coroners.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That § 7-7-1.4 be AMENDED.

7-7-1.4. Appointment--Coroner.

Notwithstanding the provisions of § 7-7-1.1, the board of county commissioners in any county with a population of sixty thousand or more may, by resolution, appoint a coroner who shall serve at the pleasure of such board. However, no board of county commissioners may exercise the authority granted pursuant to this section unless:

- (1) Not later than the April first preceding the election for coroner, the board, by resolution, adopts the appointment option; and
- (2) The appointment of any appointed coroner may not take effect until the expiration of the term of office of any duly elected coroner.
