

2024 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 17

1An Act to modify the residency requirements for voter registration and declare an2emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 12-4-1 be AMENDED:

12-4-1. A person who maintains residence, as provided in § 12-1-4, within the
state for at least thirty days in the three hundred and sixty-five days immediately prior to
submitting the registration form, and who has the qualifications of a voter prescribed by
§ 12-3-1 or 12-3-1.1, or who will have such qualifications at the next ensuing municipal,
primary, general, county, or school district election, is entitled to be registered as a voter
in the election precinct in which the person maintains residence.

- 11 A person eligible to vote may vote only in the election precinct where the person 12 maintains residence.
- Section 2. Section 1 of this Act applies retroactively to any person who registers to vote on
 or after July 1, 2023.
- 15 **Section 3.** <u>Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,</u>
- 16 <u>health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force</u>
- 17 and effect from and after its passage and approval.
