

2021 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 170

1An Act to prohibit the conduct of certain physical examinations or screenings on2students in a school district without parental consent.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5	13-1-67. Physical ExaminationsParental consent required.
6	No nonemergency, invasive physical examination or screening may be conducted
7	on any student in any school district without the prior written consent of the student's
8	parent or guardian. The school district shall obtain the written consent of the parent or
9	guardian specifically for the particular examination or screening that is being conducted.
10	No parental consent for any nonemergency, invasive physical examination or
11	screening may be included as part of a routine consent form contained in a school
12	handbook and signed annually by parents or guardians at the start of a school year. The
13	school district shall obtain parental consent separately and distinctly for each examination
14	or screening conducted.
15	For the purposes of this section, a nonemergency, invasive physical examination
16	or screening is any medical examination that involves the exposure of private body parts,
17	or any act during the examination that includes incision, insertion, or injection into the
18	body, and is:
19	(1) Required as a condition of attendance;
20	(2) Administered by the school district and scheduled by the school district in advance;
21	and
22	(3) Not necessary to protect the immediate health and safety of the student.
23	The term does not include a hearing, vision, or scoliosis screening, or a dental
24	screening or examination.
