- 1 An Act to increase the nonresident fee for a habitat stamp.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 41-6-85 be AMENDED:

**41-6-85.** Except as provided in § 41-6-10.2, a person eighteen years of age or older shall purchase a habitat stamp when applying for or purchasing a <u>fishing</u>, hunting or <u>fishing</u> furbearer license. The fee for the habitat stamp—<u>shall be is</u> ten dollars for residents and <u>twenty-five</u> <u>fifty</u> dollars for nonresidents. A person is not required to purchase more than one habitat stamp within a license period, as provided by the applicable license and rules promulgated by the commission under chapter 1-26.

Any person required to possess a <u>fishing license</u>, hunting <u>license</u>, or<u>-fishing license</u> to take <u>fur-bearing animals</u> may not fish<u>-and</u>, hunt, or trap without a <u>habitat</u> stamp <u>validation</u>.

A<u>The</u> purchase of the <u>a</u> habitat stamp is not required for the <u>a</u> one-day hunting or fishing license, <u>a</u> youth hunting license, <u>a</u> private shooting preserve license, <u>a</u> hunt for habitat application fee raffle ticket, or <u>a</u> landowner hunting license.

A-violation of person who violates this section is quilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.
