- 4 Section 1. That § 1-26D-4 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 1-26D-4. Hearing examiners have all powers delineated in §§ 1-26-19.1 and 1-26-19.2 and
- 6 shall hear all contested cases that arise under Titles 10, 25, 26, 28, and 58 and chapter 1-27.
