- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the Servicemember Firearms Protection Act.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 3 Section 1. That § 22-14-9 be amended to read:
- 4 22-14-9. Any person, other than a law enforcement officer as defined in § 22-1-2 acting
- 5 under color of authority, a servicemember as defined in § 33-1-1, or a member of the National
- 6 <u>Guard or any reserve component of the armed forces of the United States</u>, who:
- 7 (1) Carries a pistol or revolver, loaded or unloaded, concealed on or about his or her
- 8 person without a permit as provided in chapter 23-7; or
- 9 (2) Carries a pistol or revolver, loaded or unloaded, concealed in any vehicle while
- 10 operating the vehicle, without a permit as provided in chapter 23-7;
- 11 is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
