- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding state tests.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 13-3-55 be amended to read:
- 4 13-3-55. Every public school district shall annually administer the same assessment tests in algebra I, biology, and English III to all students in grades three to eight, inclusive, and in grade
- 6 eleven. Tests in English language arts and mathematics shall be administered to all students in
- 7 grades three to eight, inclusive. Tests in science shall be administered to students once in grades
- 8 three to five and once in grades six to eight. The same tests shall be administered to all students,
- 9 <u>except students with the most severe cognitive disabilities.</u> The assessment tests shall measure
- 10 the academic progress of each student. Every public school district shall annually administer to
- 11 all students in at least two grade levels an achievement test to assess writing skills. The
- 12 assessment instruments shall be provided by the Department of Education, and the department
- 13 shall determine the two grade levels to be tested. The tests shall be administered within
- 14 timelines established by the Department of Education by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter
- 15 1-26 starting in the spring of the 2002-2003 school year. Each state-designed test shall be

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- 1 correlated with the state's content standards. The South Dakota Board of Education Standards
- 2 may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to provide for administration of all assessments.
- 3 The Department of Education shall provide the tests to every public school district at no cost.
