SENATE BILL NO. 193

Introduced by: Senators Adelstein, Jerstad, Merchant, and Turbak Berry and Representatives Moser, Blake, Hunhoff (Bernie), Thompson, and Vanderlinde

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to expand medicaid eligibility for pregnant women and to
2 provide an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The Department of Social Services shall submit a Medicaid State Plan
5 amendment to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to expand medicaid
6 eligibility for pregnancy-related services for pregnant women.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million three
8 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,350,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and two
9 million five hundred seventeen thousand eighty-six dollars (\$2,517,086), or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, of federal fund expenditure authority to the Department of Social Services
11 for the purpose of providing pregnancy-related services to pregnant women.

12 Section 3. The secretary of social services shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
13 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

14 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
15 June 30, 2011, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.



1 Section 5. The Department of Social Services shall provide a report to the Governor and the
2 Legislature by January 1, 2013. The report shall include birth outcomes and any estimated
3 savings.
