- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the membership of the Judicial Qualifications
- 2 Commission.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 16-1A-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 16-1A-2. There is hereby created a Commission on Judicial Qualifications which shall
- 6 consist of seven members:
- 7 (1) Two judges of the circuit court, elected by the judicial conference;
- 8 (2) Three members One member of the bar practicing law in this state, no more than two
 9 of whom may be of the same political party, appointed by the president of the state
- 10 bar; and
- 11 (3) Two citizens who are not judges, retired judges or members of the state bar, and not
- 12 of the same political party, appointed by the Governor<u>; and</u>
- 13 (4) <u>Two sitting members of the legislature, one of whom shall be a member of the Senate</u>
- 14 and appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and one of whom shall
- 15 <u>be a member of the House of Representatives and appointed by the Speaker of the</u>



1 <u>House of Representatives</u>.

- 2 The term of office for the commission members who are members of the Legislature is two
- 3 years. The term of office for a <u>any other</u> commission member is four years. No person may serve
- 4 more than <u>four two year terms</u>, or two <u>four year</u> terms as a member of the commission.
