1	FOR AN	ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the membership of the Judicial Qualifications
2	Commission.	
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:	
4	Section 1. That § 16-1A-2 be amended to read as follows:	
5	16-17	A-2. There is hereby created a Commission on Judicial Qualifications which shall
6	consist of seven nine members:	
7	(1)	Two judges of the circuit court, elected by the judicial conference;
8	(2)	Three members of the bar practicing law in this state, no more than two of whom
9		may be of the same political party, appointed by the president a majority vote of the
0		state bar commissioners; and
1	(3)	Two citizens who are not judges, retired judges or members of the state bar, and not
12		of the same political party, appointed by the Governor; and
13	<u>(4)</u>	Two members, one of whom shall be appointed by the president pro tempore of the
4		Senate, and one of whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the House of
15		Representatives.

- The term of office for the commission members who are appointed by the Legislature is two
- 2 <u>years.</u> The term of office for a <u>any other</u> commission member is four years. No person may serve
- 3 more than <u>four two year terms</u>, <u>or two four year</u> terms as a member of the commission.
