## SENATE BILL NO. 20

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Board of Regents

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions concerning transfers of general  
2 appropriations among institutions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 4-8A-8 be amended to read:

5 4-8A-8. Moneys appropriated on a program basis by the General Appropriation Act may be  
6 transferred between program accounts within or between programs within departments and  
7 bureaus or between departments and bureaus to reflect a reorganization pursuant to ~~Article IV,~~  
8 ~~section 8 of the South Dakota Constitution~~ S.D. Const., Art. IV, § 8 only at the written request  
9 of a governing body, department secretary, or bureau commissioner, or designee, in accordance  
10 with procedures established by the Bureau of Finance and Management and only upon written  
11 approval of the Bureau of Finance and Management. Transfer of moneys appropriated by the  
12 General Appropriations Act between departments, ~~institutions,~~ and bureaus that is not necessary  
13 for a reorganization pursuant to ~~Article IV, section 8 of the South Dakota Constitution~~ S.D.  
14 Const., Art. IV, § 8 may only occur at the written request of a governing body, department  
15 secretary, or bureau commissioner, or designee, only in accordance with procedures established



1 by the Bureau of Finance and Management and only upon approval by the special committee  
2 created in this chapter. The Bureau of Finance and Management shall keep a record of all such  
3 authorizations of transfers and make them available for public inspection. Immediately after the  
4 transfer of moneys authorized by this section is approved, the bureau shall transmit an  
5 authorization notice to the special legislative committee established in § 4-8A-2 and its  
6 designees.
