- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the hunting of wolves in certain circumstances.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That subdivision (21) of § 41-1-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 (21) "Predator/varmint," coyote, wolf, gray fox, red fox, skunk, gopher, ground squirrel,
- 5 chipmunk, jackrabbit, marmot, porcupine, crow, and prairie dog;
- 6 Section 2. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 7 follows:
- Wolves may be hunted, taken, or killed in any area of the state in which wolves have been
- 9 delisted as an endangered species by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service under the
- federal Endangered Species Act, as amended to January 1, 2013.
