- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require voter registration information to be made
 available to the public by certain licensing agents.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 41-6 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:

5 At each location where hunting, fishing, or trapping licenses or permits are sold, voter 6 registration applications shall be displayed and made available to the public. A license agent 7 shall ask each person who applies for a hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit if the 8 person would like a voter registration application and may provide the voter registration 9 application to the license or permit applicant but may not assist the person with the voter 10 registration application or collect complete or incomplete voter registration applications. Each 11 person who applies for a hunting, fishing, or trapping license or permit on the internet shall be 12 provided a link to the secretary of state's online statewide voter registration application.
