## 2024 South Dakota Legislature

## **Senate Bill 21**

Introduced by: The Committee on State Affairs at the request of the Secretary of State

- An Act to rescind rule-making authority for the annual report of the number of voters removed from a county's voter registration list.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-4-54 be AMENDED:

**12-4-54.** By March first of each year, the secretary of state shall submit a report to the State Board of Elections providing the number of voters removed from the a county's voter registration list from the previous year due to inactivity, death, felony conviction, mental incompetence, or relocation to another jurisdiction.

The State Board of Elections shall promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1–26, designating the form and content of the report. The content of each the report must be made available for public inspection published on the official website of the secretary of state.
