- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to add a tribal member to the Law Enforcement Officers
- 2 Standards Commission.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 23-3-28 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 23-3-28. There is hereby created a Law Enforcement Officers Standards Commission in the
- 6 Office of the Attorney General. This commission shall consist of ten eleven members, seven
- 7 eight of whom shall be appointed by the attorney general as follows, to wit: one person from the
- 8 Division of Highway Patrol; one person who is a duly elected, qualified, and acting sheriff of
- 9 this state; one person who is a duly appointed, qualified, and acting member of a municipal
- police department of this state; one member who is an enrolled tribal member; one person who
- is a member of the State Bar of South Dakota; one member recommended by the executive
- director of the Board of Regents; one member recommended by the South Dakota Municipal
- 13 League; and one member recommended by the South Dakota County Commissioners
- 14 Association.
- The attorney general on the first appointments shall appoint three such members for terms

- of one year and four such members for a term of two years; thereafter all such appointments
- 2 shall be for two years. Any such An appointee shall be is eligible to succeed himself in office
