- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the State Brand Board to impose certain
- 2 administrative fines.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 40-21 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- Any person who violates any provision of chapters 40-20, 40-21, 40-22, or 40-29 is subject
- 7 to an administrative fine to be imposed by the board, after notice and opportunity for hearing.
- 8 The administrative fine is in addition to any criminal penalty and may not exceed five thousand
- 9 dollars for each violation. In determining the amount of the fine, or the amount of a compromise
- settlement, upon finding a violation the board may consider the appropriateness of the fine to
- the number of head of livestock involved, the gravity of the violation, prior offenses and
- 12 compliance history, the good faith of the person charged in attempting to achieve compliance,
- and such other matters as justice may require. Any fine collected pursuant to this Act shall be
- deposited in the livestock ownership inspection and theft prevention fund.
