Senate Bill 38

Introduced by: The Senate Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Bureau of Information and Telecommunications

- An Act to replace the emergency alert system and other technology, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$2,173,400 and
- also appropriated the sum of \$4,557,000 in other fund expenditure authority, to the Bureau
- 6 <u>of Information and Telecommunications, for the purpose of replacing the emergency alert</u>
- 7 <u>system and other technology.</u>
- 8 **Section 2.** The commissioner of the Bureau of Information and Telecommunications shall
- 9 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
- 10 by this Act.
- 11 **Section 3.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated revert in
- 12 <u>accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 13 **Section 4.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 14 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act is in full
- force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
