- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to specify the criminal penalty for providing care for more
- 2 than twelve children in an unregistered family day care.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 26-6-14.8 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 26-6-14.8. For the purposes of §§ 26-6-14.8 to 26-6-14.11, inclusive, unregistered family
- 6 day care means the providing care and supervision of children from more than one unrelated
- 7 family, in a family home, on a regular basis for part of a day as a supplement to regular parental
- 8 care, without transfer of legal custody or placement for adoption, without payment directly or
- 9 indirectly of any public funds. An No unregistered family day care home may not provide care
- 10 for more than twelve children at any one time including children under six living in the home.
- 11 Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
