# Senate Bill 50

*Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Bureau of Administration*

1 **An Act to make an appropriation for water, wastewater and storm water projects**  
 2 **throughout state government, and to declare an emergency.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated \$60,000,000 in federal fund expenditure authority  
 5 to the Bureau of Administration for the purpose of providing funding for eligible state agency  
 6 water, wastewater, and storm water projects.

7 **Section 2.** The commissioner of the Bureau of Administration, the secretary of corrections,  
 8 the adjutant general, the secretary of the Department of Game, Fish and Parks, the executive  
 9 director of the Board of Regents, the secretary of the Department of Agriculture and Natural  
 10 Resources, the secretary of the Department of Social Services, the secretary of the  
 11 Department of Human Services, the secretary of the Department of Transportation, the  
 12 secretary of the Department of Veterans' Affairs, and the secretary of the Department of  
 13 Education shall approve vouchers for eligible projects administered by the officials' respective  
 14 department, and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this  
 15 Act.

16 **Section 3.** The agencies listed in section 2 of this Act may adjust such cost estimates to  
 17 reflect inflation as measured by the Building Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News  
 18 Record, and additional expenditures required to comply with regulations adopted after the  
 19 effective date of this Act, or additional sums received pursuant to section 1 of this Act.  
 20 However, any adjustments to construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one  
 21 hundred and twenty-five percent of the estimated project construction cost stated in section  
 22 1 of this Act.

23 **Section 4.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall  
 24 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

- 1 **Section 5.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 2 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 3 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
