- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow the shooting of coyotes from snowmobiles.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 32-20A-11 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 32-20A-11. No Except as provided in § 32-20A-12, no person other than a law enforcement
- 5 officer or conservation officer may operate or ride in any snowmobile with any firearm in his
- 6 <u>the person's possession unless the firearm is completely unloaded and within a carrying case</u>
- 7 which encloses the entire firearm. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- 8 Section 2. That § 32-20A-12 be amended to read as follows:
- 9 32-20A-12. No person may chase, drive, harass, kill, or attempt to kill any game animal or
- 10 game bird with or from a snowmobile, except that coyotes may be taken by a landowner or
- 11 lessee on the landowner's property by shooting from stationary snowmobiles through the use of
- 12 firearms if the operator of the snowmobile is at least eighteen years of age. Not more than one
- 13 person may be aboard the snowmobile while coyotes are being hunted or taken pursuant to this
- 14 section. No property owner or lessee is liable for any damages caused by or any injury to any



- 1 person who is engaged in taking or attempting to take coyotes from a snowmobile pursuant to
- 2 <u>this section</u>. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
